

**TABLE OF CONTENTS**  
A list of the chapter titles or headings and their starting page number found at the front of the book.

**INDEX**  
An alphabetical list located at the end of a book that shows important subjects or topics.

**HEADING**  
A word or short phrase that tells the reader what the page or section is about.

**PHOTOGRAPH**  
An image of an object, person, or place taken by a camera that shows how things look in real life.

**GLOSSARY**  
An alphabetical list located at the end of the book that shows new vocabulary words and their meanings.

**KEYWORDS**  
Words or short phrases that are used to describe a subject or topic.

**CAPTION**  
Words or short sentences found by a picture that explain it in more detail.

**DIAGRAM**  
A drawing or photograph that shows the different parts of an object.

**LABELS**  
The word or short phrase that points out the different parts of an object.

**MAP**  
A flat picture that shows the location and/or features of different places on earth.

**CHART**  
A table that gives information to the reader in a more organized manner.

**GRAPH**  
Data shown in a visual way to help the reader understand information (such as a circle/pie, bar, line, or area).

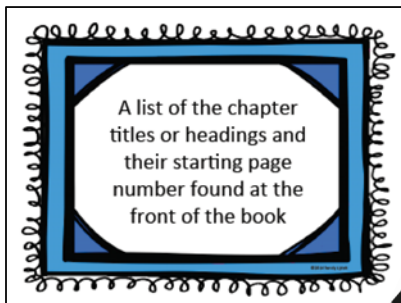
