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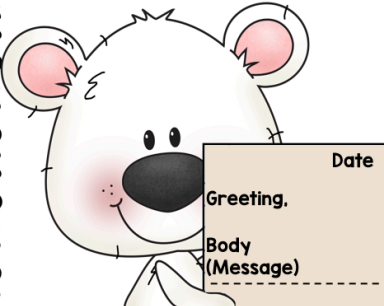
Holiday Card Station



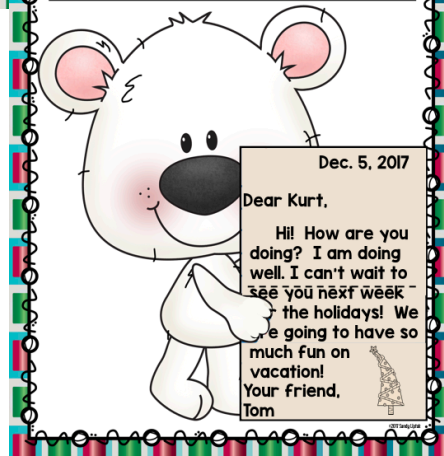
Directions:

Directions:

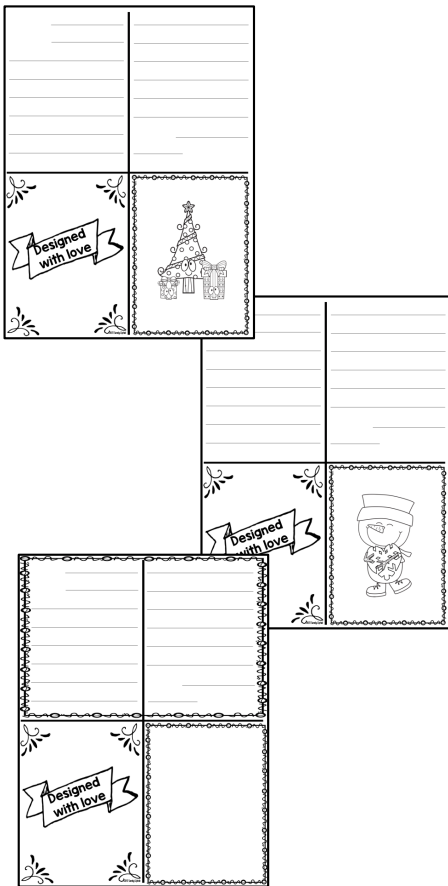
1. Take **ONE** "Battle of the Words" paper.
