REALISTIC FICTION



- Characters seem real and do real life things
- Humans act like humans and animals act like
- All events could really happen



ADVENTURE

*An exciting story in which the characters either travel on a journey or experience dangerous events

- Main character is smart and curious
- Characters travel through many action-





- *A fictional story with real and madeup characters that takes place during a historical time
- Events and features are true to the time period
- Some fact, some fiction
- Usuallu realistic



*A story that blends futuristic technology with scientific fact and fiction

- Strange society & rules
- Features technology that hasn't yet been
- Usually suspenseful





*A story that involves either funny

- characters or silly situations
- Characters like to joke around and/or play tricks
- Solutions to problems usually provoke laughter and





MYSTERY

*A suspenseful story about a puzzling event that is not solved until the end of the story

- Main character is smart and capable
- Unrelated elements are called "red herrings"





SCARY

- Unusual and spooky characters and/or
- Alarming events that often involve ghosts or other supernatural events





FANTASY

*A story including elements that are impossible

- Magic
- Superhuman abilities
- Talking animals with human characteristics
- Muthical creatures





SPORTS


*A story with a plot centering around a sport

- Problem focuses on a particular sport


