Lesson:

Welcome students to the library, and ask "Why do you come to the library?"

- Brainstorm/discuss for a few minutes possible reasons such as:

 Listen to stories, talk about different
 - Listen to stories, talk about different books, do fun activities, work on the computer, etc.
- Ask students, "Do you get to keep the books that you get from the library?"
 - Discuss that these are books to BORROW not KEEP, and we need to make sure they know how to take care of the library books.
- Read the story, Mr. Wiggle's Book by Paula M. Craig. Afterwards, review with the students how to treat library books correctly.
 - Discuss the things mentioned in the book as a whole group.
- Create a poster together with the students on Library Book Manners (See example on slide 8). Give students their Library Manners Book to color (slides 9 & 10).
 - Explain that if they bring this book back on their next library visit, they will get to check out a real library book!

Additional Activities or Books:

- Create a Library Purpose with each class/ grade level together with the students. Have them help you come up with the expectations on what to do in the library.
- You can also use the books; Winston the Book Wolf or The Library Lion





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
