Lesson:

Welcome students back to the library, and ask them "Do you remember why you come visit me in the library?"

- Let students brainstorm possible reasons such as:
 Listen to stories, talk about different books, do fun activities, work on the computer, etc. ell students "foday, we will be reading a book about a good.
- Tell students "Today, we will be reading a book about a good friend of mine, the Library Lion. Before we read, let's get our bodies ready for storytime."

Read the story. The Library Lion

- Afforwards, ask the students "Ms. Mentiweather was very particular about rule breaking". What rules or expectations do you think you need to reamender in order to have a good time when you came to the library!"
- Let the students share and write down their ideas on the board or chart paper.
- Use this to create a Library Purpose poster, and kee for further lessons as review.
- Ask students, "When you come to the library, you get to check out new bosse. What do you think the Library Lion and Mrs. Morriseather want you to do with your library books to keep them safe?"
- Left the students share ideas. Write them down on the
- board or chart paper or show the poster (slide 8) b. Hand out the Lion's Book Care page (Slide 9) for students to color and complete.


 1. Purchase a stuffed "lion" and use that as a mascot for the library.

- 4) Most of the lessons have included printable activities that students can do by themselves or with partners.







